Miami Beach VFW Post 3559 is uniquely positioned:

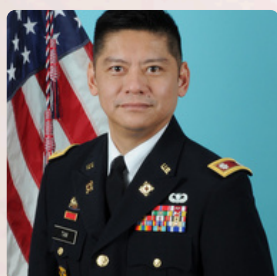
- One of the most scenic and desirable VFW locations globally, directly on Biscayne Bay

Our vision is to solidify Post 3559 as a flagship VFW Post, a national model that other Posts across the country can learn from and replicate.

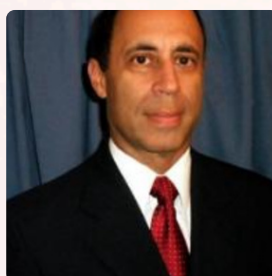

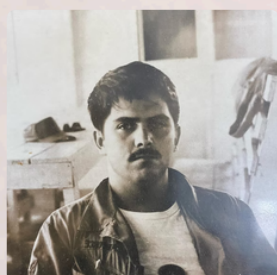

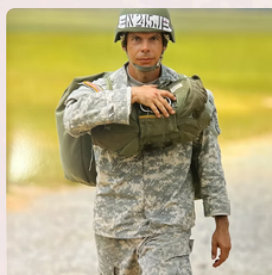

MISSION VERTICALS

WELLNESS EVENTS

Initiatives include leadership and speaker forums, fitness and wellness events, skills-based classes, and community activities designed to build camaraderie, reduce isolation, and help veterans stay sharp and connected.



BUSINESS INITIATIVES

Through Operation Next Mission, the Post delivers business education, job-readiness vetting, employer partnerships, and quarterly pitch competitions awarding \$5,000 grants to veteran-led ventures, creating clear pathways to sustainable careers.



POST INFRASTRUCTURE

Investments include upgrades to the event space, bar and canteen, and kitchen infrastructure—along with aesthetic and operational improvements, transforming the Post into a professional, revenue-capable community hub worthy of its national visibility.



COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

To broaden the Miami/Miami Beach community, programs include *Toys for Tots* drives, cemetery military head stone clean ups, Girl Scout engagement, patriotic instruction, and the proper flag retirement for more than three thousand tattered, torn, and faded flags throughout Miami Beach, utilizing four Flag Boxes, purchased by the Post and its Auxiliary, and facilitating the Voice of Democracy and Patriot's Pen scholarship awards. that promote civic pride, service, and intergenerational connection.



VETERAN WELLNESS, SKILLS & CAMARADERIE

1. WELLNESS EVENTS

Funding will expand programs that strengthen veterans mentally, physically, and socially, including:

- Weekly Warrior Wednesday speaker series and battle-buddy check-in meetings.
- Fitness and wellness events
- Skill-building classes and workshops
- Social and recreational activities that build camaraderie and reduce isolation

Impact: Healthier veterans, stronger bonds, lifelong skills.



VETERAN JOB PLACEMENT & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

2. BUSINESS INITIATIVES

Through the Operation Next Mission, funds will support:

- Utilizing the Miami Beach VFW Business Base Co-working space for meetings and networking
- Veteran business and entrepreneurship classes
- Quarterly pitch competitions with \$5,000 grants awarded each quarter
- Job placement vetting and readiness pathways
- Pre-qualification pipelines for veteran hiring with partner companies

Impact: Veterans transition into meaningful employment, ownership, and economic independence.



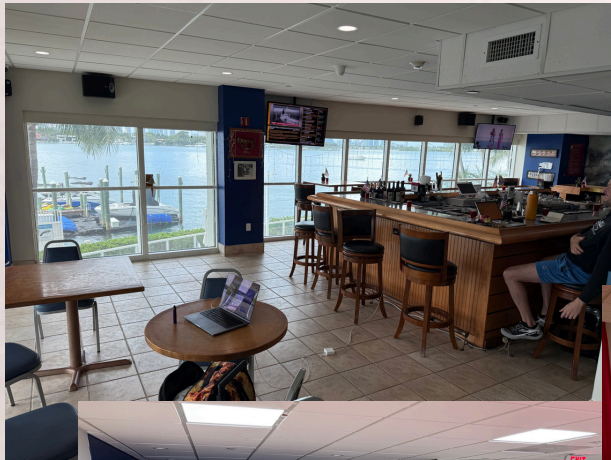

- Event space enhancements
- Bar and canteen improvements
- Aesthetic and functional renovations

Impact: A modern, revenue-capable Post that can host large-scale events, fund its mission sustainably, and welcome the community with pride.

4. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Miami Beach VFW Post 3559 is a civic connector.
Funds will support:

- *Toys for Tots* holiday drives
- Cemetery Military Headstone restoration
- Voice of Democracy & Patriot Pen Scholarships
- Support for veteran led youth programs and activities

Impact: Stronger community ties, visible veteran leadership, and investment in the next generation.

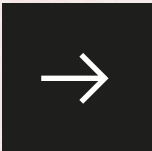

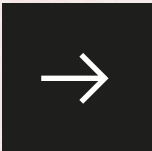
